**Hong Kong St. John Ambulance** has been established in Hong Kong for 139 years. It was first started in 1884 in the name of “Hong Kong St. John Ambulance Association” and inaugurated in 1900. The **Brigade** was formally established in 1916 during World War I, followed by the establishment of the **Council** in 1949 after World War II. In 2015, Hong Kong was upgraded as a **Priory** of the Order of St. John. As an ex-officio member of the Grand Council of the Order, Hong Kong ever since then has a broader scope of involvement in international policies and activities.

Hong Kong St. John Ambulance has been well-known in the provision of First Aid training and Ambulance services to the general public in Hong Kong. The principle and spirit of Hong Kong St. John Ambulance as embodied in the motto “**For the Service of Mankind**” remain unchanged after the enactment of the new **Hong Kong St. John Ambulance Incorporation Ordinance (Chapter 1164)** on 27 June 1997. Hong Kong St. John Ambulance continues in promoting and encouraging all works of humanity and charity for the relief of distress, suffering, sickness, danger and poverty without any distinction as to colour, class or creed.

The **Council** is the supreme governing body of **Hong Kong St. John Ambulance** and is charged with the governance, management and control of all businesses and activities of the Corporation. The Council is composed of dedicated volunteers from various professions and the Assistant Director (Administration and Policy) of the Department of Health also sits in the Council as an observer. The Council’s work is facilitated by its standing Committees, namely, Two MacDonnell Road Management, Finance, Honours and Awards, Public Relations, Property Management and Development, Greater China Affairs, Ambulance Service Steering and Information Technology.

The **Association**, the training branch, has been the premier organization of the territory responsible for instructing members of the general public the principles and practice of First Aid, Home Nursing and allied subjects since 1884. The **Director’s Conference** ensures that training works of the Association are conducted effectively and efficiently. There are 537 volunteer lecturers or instructors, including doctors, nurses, allied health professionals and non-professionals.

The **Brigade**, the service branch, is responsible for organizing training and equipping adult and youth members to undertake, on a voluntary basis, First Aid, Home Nursing, Ambulance and Community Services to those in need. The services are free. The **Commissioner’s Conference** is responsible for overseeing the organization, administration, services provision and development of the Brigade. At present, there are 7,647 members, made up of 3,415 Adult and 4,232 Youth members including 189 members from St. John Pandas.



Serving the community through the voluntary work of St. John has given me great pleasure, pride and satisfaction. I would like to express my sincere appreciation and heartfelt gratitude to my fellow Members of the Council for their unfailing trust, valuable advice and strong support in my chairmanship, which are essential for meeting our challenges all along and ahead.

The fiscal year 2022/23 continued to be a difficult one for the organization as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. All our trainings, first aid duties and ambulance services were intermittently disrupted. Nevertheless, we could still arrange substantial training activities through e-learning and webinar. The number of students trained by the Association last year was 111,679 or 136% of the previous year (82,394), while subvention from the Department of Health required 21,000 participants only. In fact, it broke our historical record of 2016/17. At the same time, first aid duties, dental activities and ambulance services were recovering. The Brigade provided 138,503 man-hours of first aid, dental and community services, doubling that of the previous year (67,430), but it was only about 80% of our performance pledge of 170,000 man-hours annually! As our insurance plan did not cover infectious disease contracted during voluntary works, we had to hire more ambulance staff to replace voluntary first-aiders. This increased our financial burden substantially. On the other hand, our ambulance staff had to take extra precautionary measures for infectious disease protection, and extra hours in ambulance cleansing after transporting confirmed or suspected COVID-19 cases, as our ambulance team had the additional work of helping the Fire Services Department and the Hospital Authority in transporting cases to and from hospitals, quarantine centres and residences. With the drastically increased demand for emergency interhospital transport, we were able to partially meet our performance indicators with the Department of Health after failing for 8 consecutive years (11,032 emergency and 484 non-emergency compared with our performance pledges of 7,000 emergency calls and 750 non-emergency duties). In the first quarter of this year, the Hong Kong Government step-by-step dropped mandatory isolation/quarantine requirements, compulsory mask and COVID-19 tests. Hopefully, all activities can now return to normal. Recently, first-aid volunteer are eager to help in the first aid and ambulance services and optimistically we can meet our performance pledges once again.

St. John was active in helping the fight against COVID-19. As mentioned above, our ambulance service was busy in transporting COVID-19 confirmed or suspected cases to and from hospitals, quarantine centres or residences. First aid, medical consultation and ambulance support were provided to construction site workers of 6 Mobile Cabin Hospitals from February to June last year. In response to the appeal of the Government, Outreach Vaccination Teams were formed in March to August last year to provide CoronaVac vaccinations to the elderly and handicapped in Residential Care Homes. The teams comprised doctors, nurses, dentists, first aid lecturers, officers and members, visited 49 Residential Care Homes and delivered 5,145 doses of vaccine.

Active preparation has been kicked off since October 2021 under the chairmanship of Dr. Peter Wong for an exhibition titled **"Pre-hospital Cardiac Resuscitation – Past and Present"**. Valuable and interesting old documents, manuals and equipment have been donated or on loan from members and friendly sales agents. Unfortunately, the 5<sup>th</sup> wave of COVID-19 in the first half of last year forced us to postpone. Finally, the exhibition is ready on the 6<sup>th</sup> Floor of St. John Tower, and there will be an opening ceremony and press conference tomorrow (24 June 2023). Interesting information including equipment, books, videos and posters will be displayed till the end of August this year. I hope this will stimulate the general public to learn CPR and AED.

St. John has been lagging behind for decades with the trend for specialization and modernization of its ambulance service, which remains at the basic level. Twelve full-time ambulance staff were sent to the Fire and Ambulance Services Academy in March this year for a 5-day refresher course. A formal Ambulance Aid course for St. John staff and volunteers is in the pipeline.

With the growth of the organization, demand for training, meeting and office facilities has put us under pressure. A plan to redevelop the Kowloon Command Headquarters back to a Mainland Command Headquarters has been endorsed in principle by the Council and a feasibility study is currently in progress.

My St. John dream is to train up our ambulance crew to internationally recognized level and to have all school students trained in First Aid. I shall work hard towards this direction during my next term of office.

The achievement and success that have been made by Hong Kong St. John Ambulance would not be possible without the full dedication and commitment of our volunteers and staff, who have served conscientiously to uphold the highest tradition of St. John in every way. To them, I wish to express my sincere thankfulness and appreciation for their admirable work. In addition, the generosity and guidance of the Department of Health, Home and Youth Affairs Bureau, Hong Kong Jockey Club, Community Chest and other donors keep us on the right track to respond to the needs of our local community, enabling the continuation and expansion of our services and works.

With the fading away of the COVID-19 pandemic, I am confident that St. John will grow from strength to strength and strive to provide better services for the community. Glory goes to every member of Hong Kong St. John Ambulance.



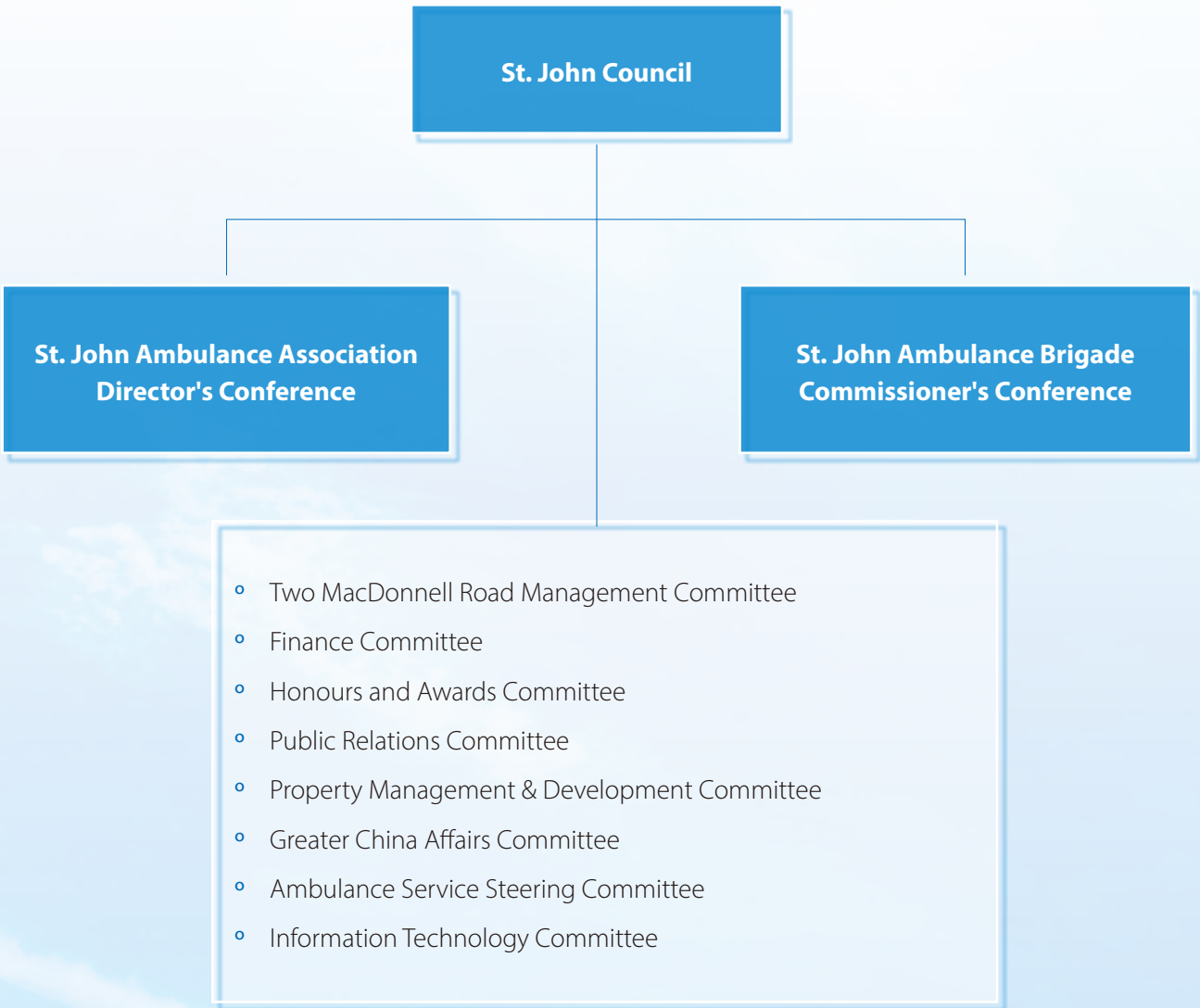

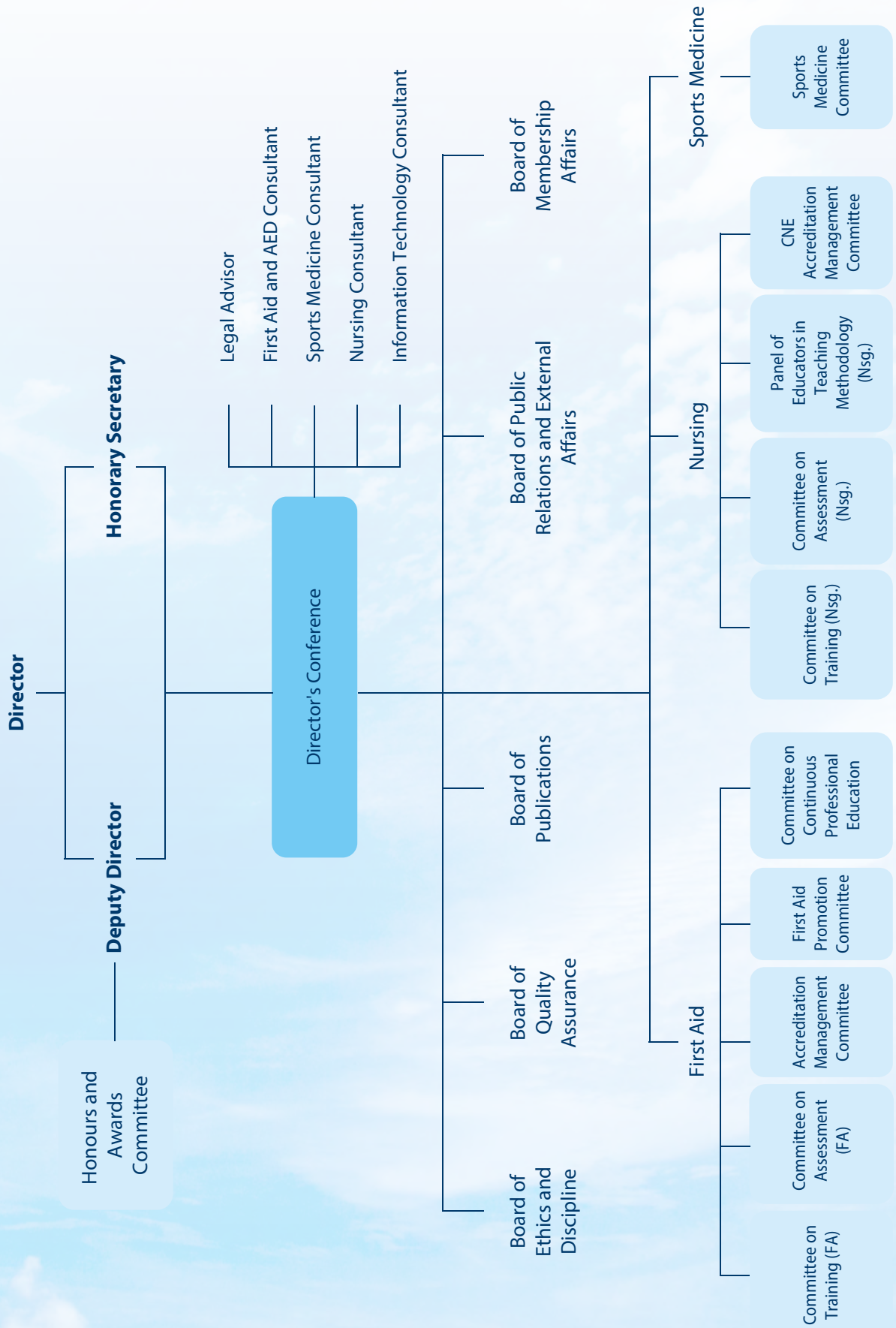

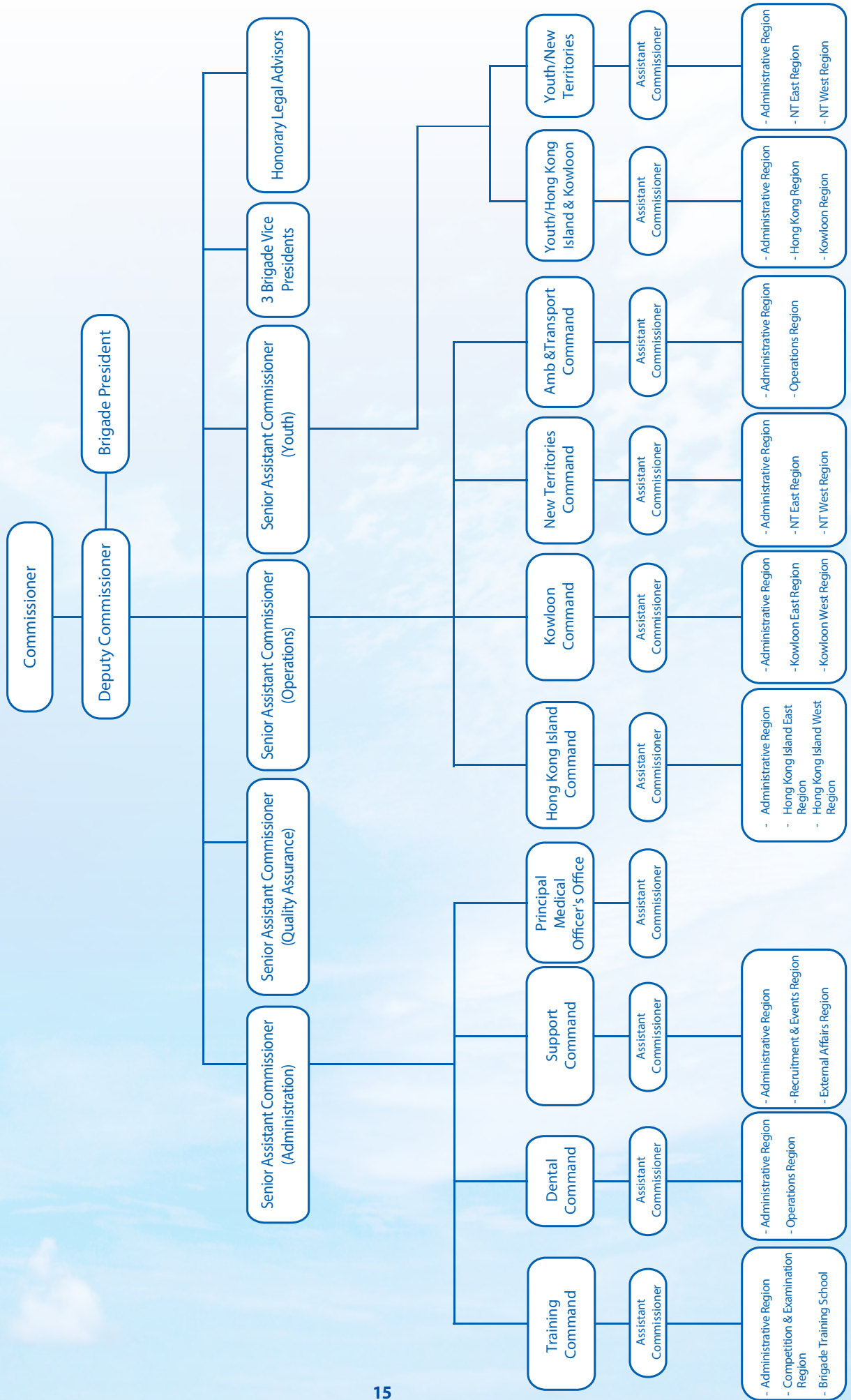

- 1. Grand Council Meeting 2022** was held in London from 20 to 23 June 2022. Dr. Chung Ching-hung, Prior of The St. John Priory of Hong Kong and Ms. Susanna Chow Chui-san, Chief Executive Officer had attended the meeting. It was a fruitful meeting in many ways. The Council had discussions on many topics of common concern for St. John worldwide, especially the St. John Values which were stressed and the new model of ambulance and equipment were displayed during the International Executive Meeting.



## 2. Provision of First Aid Service at Mobile Cabin Hospitals

St. John Brigade deployed over 840 personnel to provide first aid standby services at 6 Mobile Cabin Hospitals during their construction period, to ensure a safe and secure environment for those construction workers from 27 February 2022 till 30 June 2022.



## 3. St. John Outreach Vaccination Team

With the surge of the 5<sup>th</sup> wave of the COVID-19 pandemic in Hong Kong, there was an alarming increase in the death rate among the elderly in Residential Care Homes (RCHs) who had not been vaccinated. In order to suppress the spread of infected cases within the elderly centres and to reduce the source of infection, St. John mobilized over 600 personnel including Doctors, Nurses, Dentists, First Aid Lecturers, Officers and Members to set up a St. John Vaccination Team (The Team). The Team aimed at providing outreach vaccination service to those elderly or handicapped residents at Residential Care Homes for taking at least the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccination. Adhered to our motto "For the Service of Mankind", the Team visited infection-prone centres to assess and vaccinate the residents. Commencing from 10 March 2022-29 August 2022, the Team visited 49 RCHs with 5,145 doses of vaccines given.



## 4. Ambulance Transport of COVID-19 Patients and Contacts Between Residence and Hospital or Quarantine Facilities

St. John ambulances had been transferring confirmed COVID-19 cases to Quarantine Centres, designated hospitals, Asia World Expo (AWE) or North Lantau Hospital Hong Kong Infection Control Centre (HKICC) for treatment since August 2020. Over 1,400 patients had been handled. St. John ambulances also assisted the Government in transferring the elderly after completing the quarantine order from the Quarantine Centres, designated hospitals, AWE or HKICC back to the elderly centres/homes. Over 600 patients had been handled.

## 5. Annual General Meeting 2022 was held on Friday, 24 June 2022 at the newly renovated Aw Boon Haw Hall, Hong Kong St. John Ambulance Headquarters with Dr. Chung Chin-hung, Council Chairman chaired the meeting.



## 6. The Installation and Investiture of Dr. Steve Evans as Sub Prior of The Order of St John by The Grand Prior Prince Richard, Duke of Gloucester, was held on Wednesday, 7 December 2022 at the Priory Church, Clerkenwell, London. Dr. Chung Chin-hung, The Prior of The St. John Priory of Hong Kong attended the said ceremony. As a member of the Trustees' Executive Committee of the Order, Dr. Chung also attended the Committee meeting held at St. John International Headquarters, Charterhouse Mews, London, on the previous day.





7. The **Investiture and Presentation of Prior's Commendation** was held at St. John's Cathedral on Saturday, 19 November 2022. The Prior of The St. John Priory of Hong Kong, Dr. Chung Chin-hung presented the St. John Insignia to 21 award recipients with 2 Commanders, 7 Officers and 12 Members who had been admitted to or promoted in the Order as a result of having demonstrated successfully their leadership, integrity and notable service to the organization.

In the same occasion, 1 Brigade Officer received Prior's Commendation in recognition of his participation in the successful resuscitation of the life of a drowning patient in cardiac arrest on a speedboat at Sai Kung by performing Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) during an off-duty incident on 21 June 2022.



8. **The St. John Asia Pacific Regional Meeting** was held in Brisbane from 16-17 January 2023. Ms. Susanna Chow Chui-san, Chief Executive Officer attended and represented The St. John Priory of Hong Kong. Representatives from St. John International Office, Australia, New Zealand, Fiji, Papua New Guinea, Solomon Island, Sri Lanka and various States in Australia including WA, NSW, SA and ACT attended the Meeting. The issues on the possibility of having one standard for first aid training across all St. John establishments, the new structure of the St. John International Office and the support they could provide were discussed.



## 9. St. John International Women's Network

Council Member, Dr. Sylvia Chan May-kuen and Brigade Assistant Commissioner (Training), Dr. Choi Yim-ping have been representing The St. John Priory of Hong Kong to participate in the St. John International Women's Network since September 2021. The Network is a global platform aims to recognize, celebrate and enhance the vital contributions of women within the St. John family. It strives to support and promote greater gender diversity across all St. John branches, including the Priories, Associations and the Eye Hospital.



10. The **Hong Kong St. John Ambulance Annual Dinner** was held on Saturday, 25 March 2023 at Gordon Wu Hall, BP International House. Under the competent chairmanship of Dr. Donald Li Kwok-tung, Association Director and Dr. Alfred So Ping-fai, Brigade Commissioner, the feedback was overwhelming. 46 tables were taken up and over 500 members of St. John attended the dinner.



11. A group of 4 representatives of **St. John Ambulance of Malaysia** led by Dato' Yeo Kim Thong Burnard, Vice Council Chairman of St. John Ambulance of Malaysia paid a courtesy visit to The St. John Priory of Hong Kong from 21 to 27 March 2023. The group visited the Hong Kong St. John Ambulance Headquarters, Hong Kong Island Command Headquarters, St. John Ambulance Control Centre, First Aid Post at Tai Mei Tuk and Shatin outlying training centre. A variety of courses demonstration, training observation, ISO Quality Management Experience Sharing and VR demonstration were arranged for the representatives.





## 12. Re-Certification of ISO 9001:2015 (Certificate No. FS 708014)

Hong Kong St. John Ambulance was awarded Certificate of Registration ISO 9001:2015 in February 2020 with the scope “The provision of training services of Certificate in First Aid, Automated External Defibrillation Provider and Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation courses at St. John Tower”.

From 2020 onwards, St. John follows the international quality management system and operates a Quality Management System which complies with the requirement of ISO 9001: 2015 of the same scope.

The triannual re-assessment was conducted by British Standards Institute (BSI) independently against internationally recognized standards in January 2023. The ISO certification acts as an assurance that courses and services of St. John are of international quality and standard.



**13. The Secretary for Home Affairs (SHA) Commendation Scheme** aims to commend individuals for their long-term dedication towards the training and development of youths in Uniformed Groups (UGs), distinguished community services, or support to the promotion of culture and sports. There were two types of award, namely, the “UG Volunteer Leader (UGVL)” and “UG Youth Volunteer Leader (UGYVL)” presented to selected nominees with distinguished performance from the local Uniformed Groups under the administration of the Home and Youth Affairs Bureau.

In 2021, Senior Superintendent Lee Ping-yung and Superintendent Ma Hiu-wa of the Youth Command were awarded the UGVL, whereas Senior Ambulance Officer Fung Hiu-tung and Probationary Ambulance Officer Ng Nga-ting were awarded the UGYVL in recognition of their outstanding and continuous contribution in youth services through Hong Kong St. John Ambulance Brigade Youth Command. The Presentation Ceremony was held on Saturday, 11 June 2022.



## 14. Re-accreditation of Certificate in Health Worker Training, Certificate in Advanced Training for Health Workers and Foundation Certificate in Training for Care Workers – QF Level 2 & 3

Certificate in Health Worker Training, Certificate in Advanced Training for Health Workers and Foundation Certificate in Training for Care Workers were granted accreditation status at Quality Framework (QF) from the Hong Kong Council for Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications (HKCAAVQ) in 2019, the former two were in Level 3 and the latter one was in Level 2.

Three courses have been re-accredited by HKCAAVQ under Qualification Framework (QF) in 2022, with validity until 30 June 2026.

### Demise

The Former Council Chairman and Honorary Council Member Dr. David Mok Lai-foo, KStJ passed away peacefully on 16 April 2022.



1. During the reporting year, the Brigade discharged a total of 138,503.25 man-hours of volunteer first aid, ambulance duties, dental and community services for the public.
2. In 2022/2023, the Brigade responded to 11,516 emergency and non-emergency calls for ambulance services. A detailed breakdown of these calls is tabulated below for easy reference.

### 3. Dental Service

The dental service provided by Hong Kong St John Ambulance Brigade has been in operation for over 72 years.

Free dental service is made available to the elderly and patients with special needs by Brigade volunteer dentists, dental surgery assistants and members at the Dental Clinic located at the St. John Headquarters or elderly homes by the Outreach Team. In addition, oral health services are provided to the public through campaigns and special events.

The fiscal year 2022/2023 was another challenging year for the dental service due to the 5<sup>th</sup> wave of COVID-19 pandemic in Hong Kong. As a result, the dental clinic and outreach service were completely suspended till June 2022. However, service had been continued through email to over 100 organizations to educate patients on oral hygiene by PowerPoint presentation. Feedback was very positive because prevention is always better than cure.

In 2022/2023, volunteers in the Dental Command provided dental services to a total of 223 patients with 431 cases being treated in the dental clinic. The number of patients increased steadily throughout the year. The members of public received various services including free consultation, oral examination, dental prophylaxis, filling and extraction.



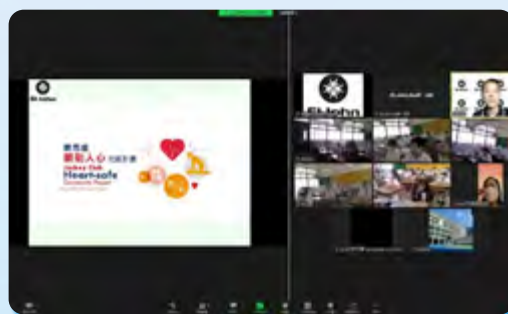
## For the Public/Organizations

### 1. Jockey Club Heart-safe Community Project (賽馬會「顫動人心」社區計劃)

Funding has been granted from the Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust for installation of automated external defibrillators (AED) and provision of training programmes for 1,600 social service units for three years. The project has been carried out in collaboration with Hong Kong Red Cross, kicking off in December 2019 along with Public Educational Talk on learning first aid skills to the public.

As at 31 March 2023, 796 CPR and AED training courses were held with a total of 5,866 participants. Over 90% participants agreed that awareness on the importance of CPR and AED was enhanced and had confidence in using the AED and performing CPR after attending the course.

1,418 public educational talks were organized, including 69 talks held online with 40,133 participants attended. Most of them agreed that the talks were useful and practical. 809 AEDs were installed in social service units and all were satisfied with the arrangements of installation.



### 2. Advanced Life Support in Obstetrics (ALSO)

ALSO Provider courses were jointly organized by the Hong Kong College of Emergency Medicine and the Hong Kong College of Obstetricians & Gynaecologists for the 12<sup>nd</sup> consecutive year. To facilitate course participants to attend the course effectively, a blended learning mode was introduced. The blended mode allowed course participants to study the theory online and practise knowledge and skills at the face-to-face sessions. 5 ALSO courses were conducted from 16 to 20 May 2022 at St. John Tower with 178 nurses and doctors participated.





### 3. Advanced Medical Life Support (AMLS) Course

The Association has launched the Advanced Medical Life Support course developed by the National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians (NAEMT) of the United States since 2016. Apart from the didactic aspects, interactive simulations and problem solving scenarios have given participants realistic exposure to similar cases. In 2022, AMLS courses were conducted in June, August, September and December 2022 with approximately 90 participants attended.



### 4. All Hazards Disaster Response (AHDR) Provider Course

Developed by the National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians (NAEMT), supported by the American College of Emergency Physicians, the All Hazards Disaster Response (AHDR) course teaches students how to respond to different types of disaster scenario they may encounter, including natural disasters and infrastructure failing, fire and radiological event, pandemic, active shooter incident, and other mass casualty events. AHDR educates participants on how to analyse potential threats in their area, assess available resources and create a response plan that will save lives. It is an 8-hour classroom course for Emergency Medical Service practitioners at all levels. 1 AHDR course was conducted on Thursday, 1 September 2022 with 26 participants attended.



## 5. Free Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Automated External Defibrillation (AED) Training Courses for Members of the Public

The Sir Robert Ho Tung Charitable Fund has granted the Association funding for conducting free 6-hour CPR & AED training for members of the public since 2010. The project was conducted from 11 November 2022 to 31 March 2023. The number of participants was 3,777 with 65 courses. All qualified participants were awarded the Adult CPR and AED Provider Certificate with 3 years validity. Positive comments were received.



## 6. Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Education Projects of Rotary 2022-2023

The Association has been invited by the Rotary Club of Hong Kong Northeast, collaborating with Hong Kong College of Cardiology to conduct the CPRAED course for members of the public for the 7<sup>th</sup> year with over 5,000 members of the public trained in the project. The targeted beneficiaries were students and staff from schools.

This year, the Opening Ceremony of the Project was officiated by Dr. Ko Wing-man, GBS, JP on Saturday, 19 November 2022 at St. John Tower. The latest CPR/AED machine and technique was demonstrated by students from Queen's College and YLPMSAA Tang Siu Tong Secondary School.





**7. Basic Life Support in Obstetrics (BLSO™) Provider Course**

The American Academy of Family Physicians (AAFP) has granted the Association a licence of conducting Basic Life Support in Obstetrics (BLSO™) Provider Course since 2017. The course objective is to provide training of pre-hospital care providers who wish to increase their knowledges and skills in the field of obstetrics. In 2022-23, the courses were conducted in July, August, December 2022 and March 2023 with 86 candidates attended.



**8. Basic Psychological Life Support (BPLS) Course**

The 2-day BPLS Courses jointly developed by the Association and the Institute of Mental Health, Castle Peak Hospital were held from August to November 2022 and March 2023. Participants joined the course to learn about emotion, anxiety, stress, positive psychology, common mental illness, together with the skills for managing panic patients. 6 BPLS courses were conducted from August to December 2022 and March 2023.



**9. Pet First Aid and Emergency Care Course (PETFA)**

Pet First Aid and Emergency Care Course was launched in 2015, which has grown in popularity since the first class. 16 classes were held from May 2022 to March 2023. One Veterinarian delegated by the Hong Kong Veterinary Association (HKVA) would be one of the instructors in each course.



## 10. Pre-hospital Trauma Life Support (PHTLS) Courses

The Association has become the sole provider of PHTLS courses in Hong Kong since 2002. The course was developed by the National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians (NAEMT) of the United States and was introduced into Hong Kong by the China-Hong Kong Chapter of the American College of Surgeons. This 2-day intensive course gives instructions on kinematics of injuries, assessment and management of trauma patients with multiple injuries. Prospective trainees include doctors, nurses and pre-hospital care providers. Three courses were conducted in August, September and December 2022 with around 90 candidates attended.



## 11. First Aid Specialty Course on Sports Emergencies

With the successful promotion of First Aid Specialty Course on Sports Emergencies, the “Sports Medicine Committee” (運動醫學小組) was formally established in September 2008. Also, the Committee aims to design a strategic plan for the development of sports related courses or workshops; and to serve as the responsible body for continuous quality assurance of sports courses held. It is an honor to have Dr. Wilson Li, Sports Medicine Consultant, as the Chairman of the Committee. The Committee was reviewing and preparing a revised edition manual for the public and other interested parties, especially those working in sports and recreation areas.

9 Sports Emergencies courses were conducted from June to December 2022 and February to March 2023.



## 12. Certificate of Competency in First Aid for Tourist Guide & Tour Escort

The Association was invited by the Travel Industry Authority to conduct Certificate of Competency in First Aid for tour escorts and tourist guides to obtain a valid certificate of competency in first aid in October 2022. The course objectives are:

- ✦ to introduce principles of First Aid;
- ✦ to equip trainees with basic principles of First-Aid and Automated External Defibrillation to strengthen their techniques in performing basic First-Aid treatments for tourists; and
- ✦ to raise their awareness of safety.



## For St. John Lecturers/Instructors/Officers and Members

### 1. A Hybrid Mode Seminar

A hybrid mode seminar 『教學素質研討會 2022』 was conducted on 21 September 2022 with highlights as below:

- ✦ summary of the learning points of the previous complaint cases;
- ✦ current teaching methodology;
- ✦ the promotion of the Qualification Framework and ISO9001 awarded for St. John courses; and
- ✦ COVID-19 outstanding issues to the Lecturers by Training Manager, Dr. Chau Chi-wai, Dr. Kenneth Chan Tsan-ming and Dr. Leung Yui-kei. Over 90 participants joined in person and via zoom at the same time.



### 2. AEDI Workshop 『急救學講師增潤工作坊 2022/23』

An AEDI Workshop for First Aid Lecturers to become AED instructors was conducted on 10 August 2022 at St. John Tower with 35 First Aid Lecturers attended. 32 Lecturers have already completed and passed the assessment and become AED instructors.



### 3. Training for St. John Ambulance Staff

To enhance the basic first aid skills of ambulance staff of St. John, the Association conducted on-job training for 17 ambulance staff in August and September 2022. Courses included Advanced Medical Life Support, First Aid Specialty Course on Sports Emergencies, All Hazards Disaster Response Provider Course, Basic Psychological Life Support Course, Basic Life Support in Obstetrics Course and Home Nursing 2020.

Moreover, a group of 12 ambulance staff attended the ambulance training course organized by Fire Services Department at Fire and Ambulance Services Academy from 20 to 24 March 2023.



4. Training and activities for Cadets and Adult members of the Brigade personnel & Youth Command were organized separately by the Brigade with the support from Headquarters staff. A summary of the trainings is as below:

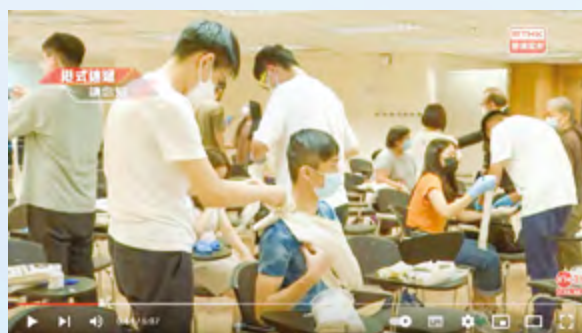

## 7. Publicity in various Local Media

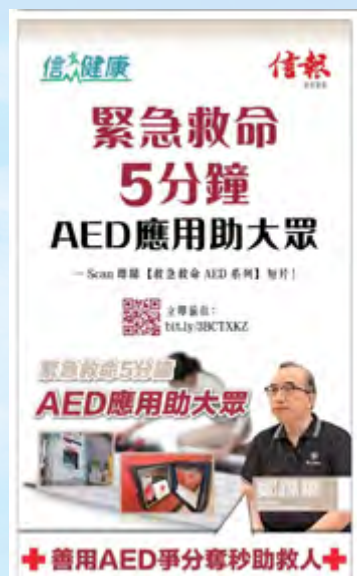

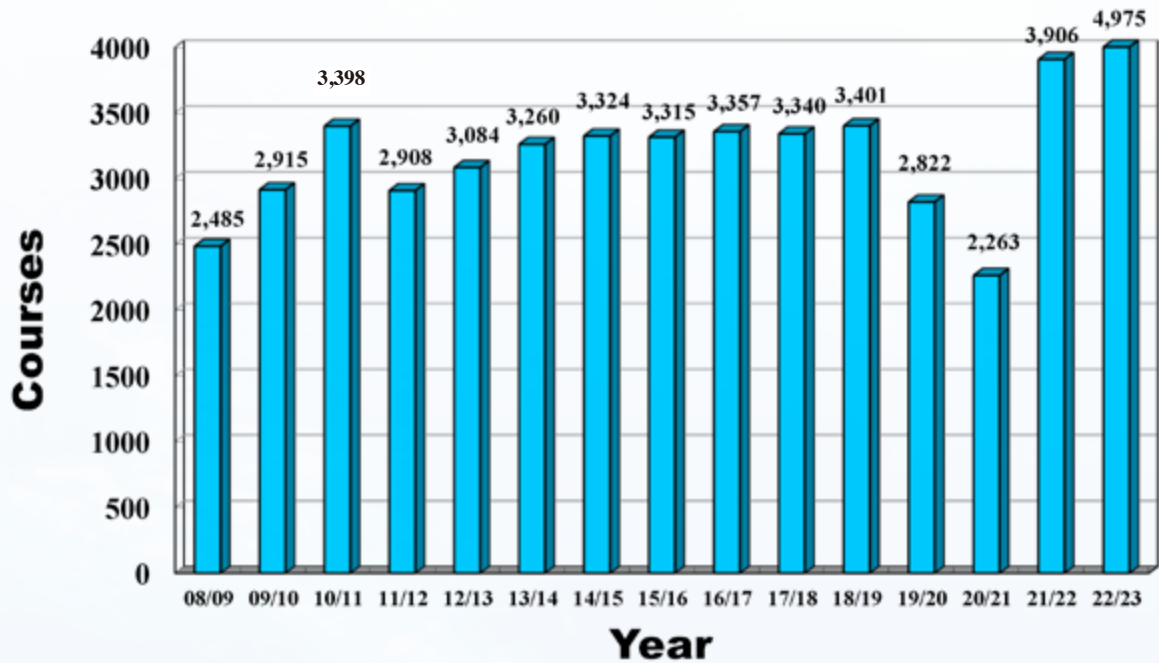

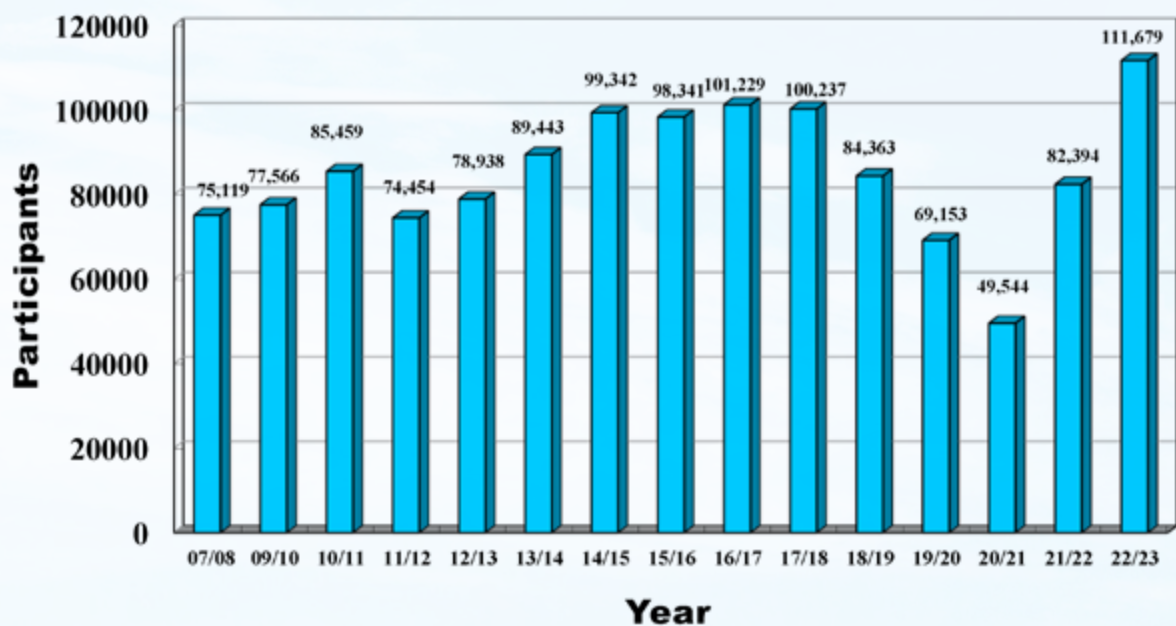

### Total number of Training Courses conducted by the Association (2008-2023)

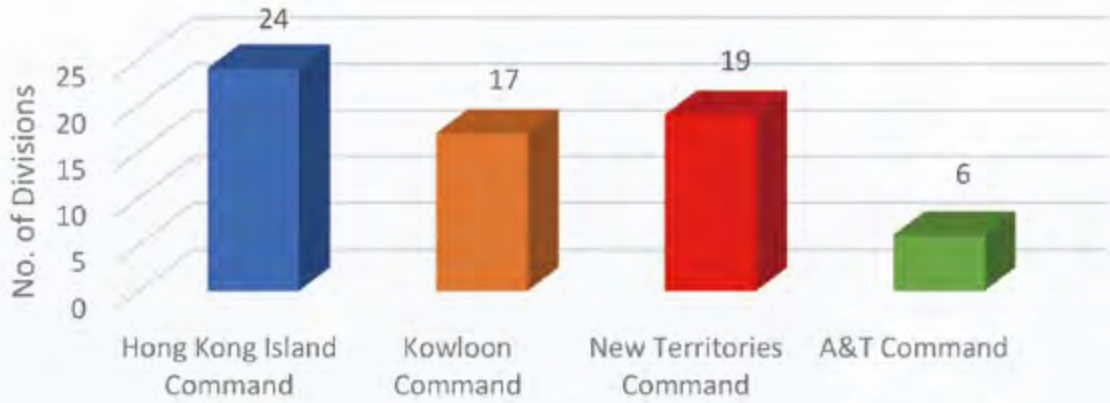


### Total number of participants enrolled in Training Courses conducted during (2008-2023)

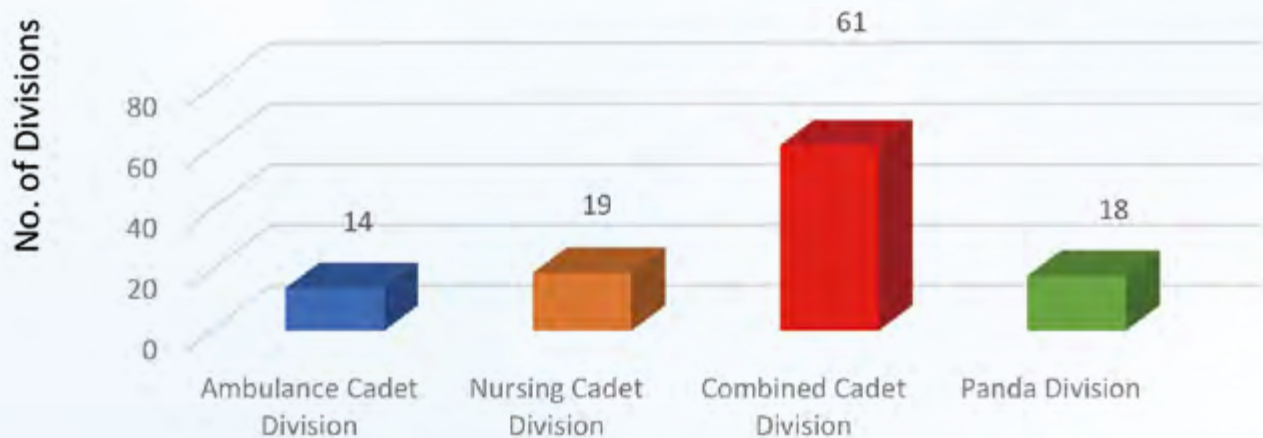




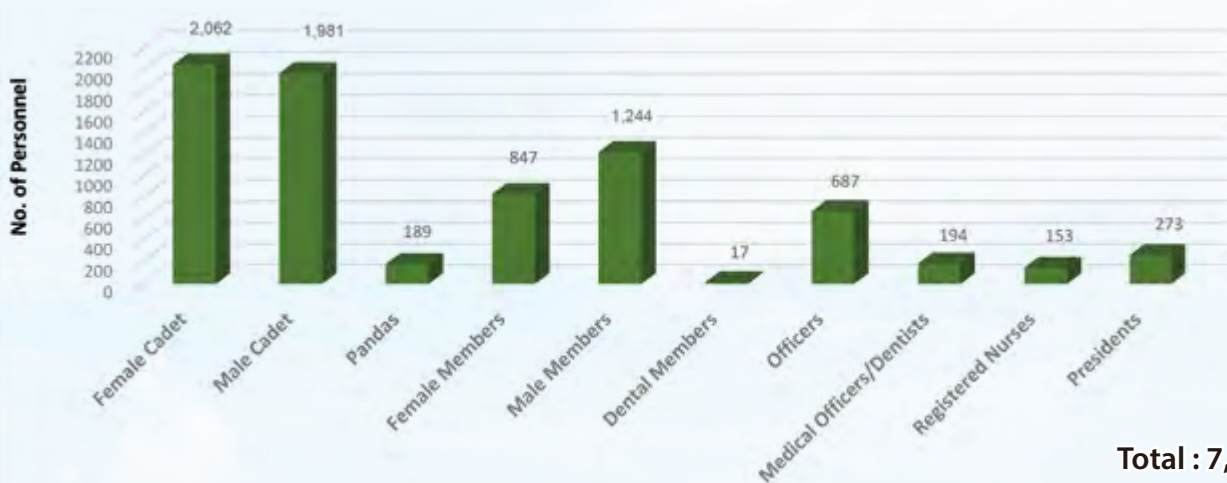
### Number of Divisions in the Hong Kong Island / Kowloon / New Territories / Ambulance & Transport Command



### Number of Divisions in the Youth Command

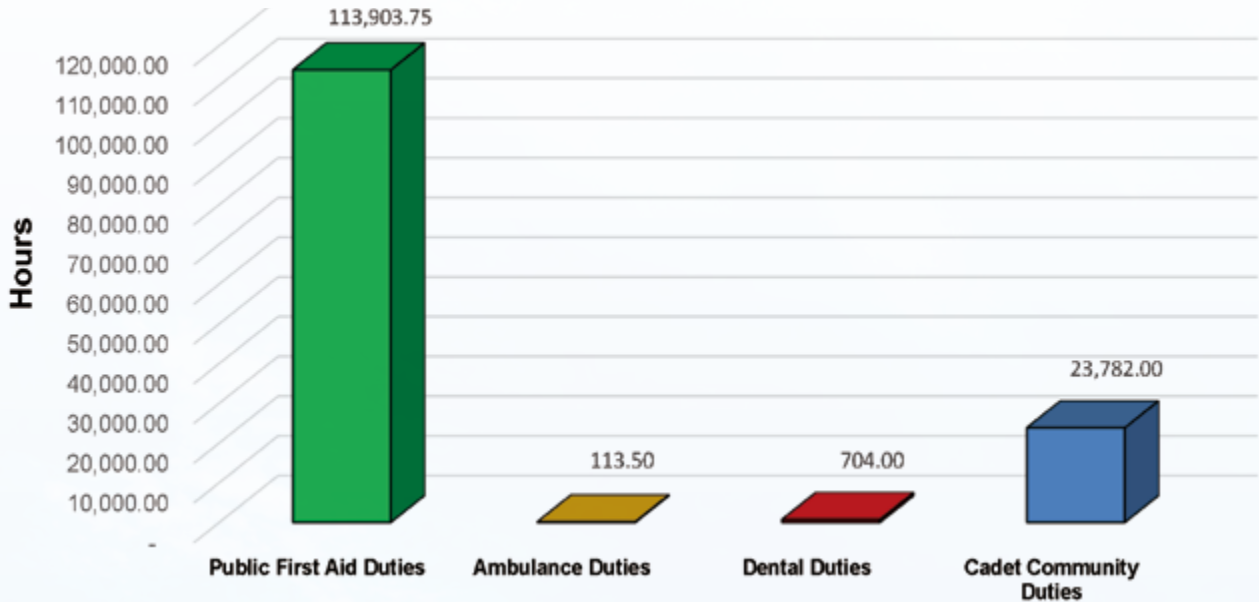


### Strength of the Brigade as at 31 March 2023



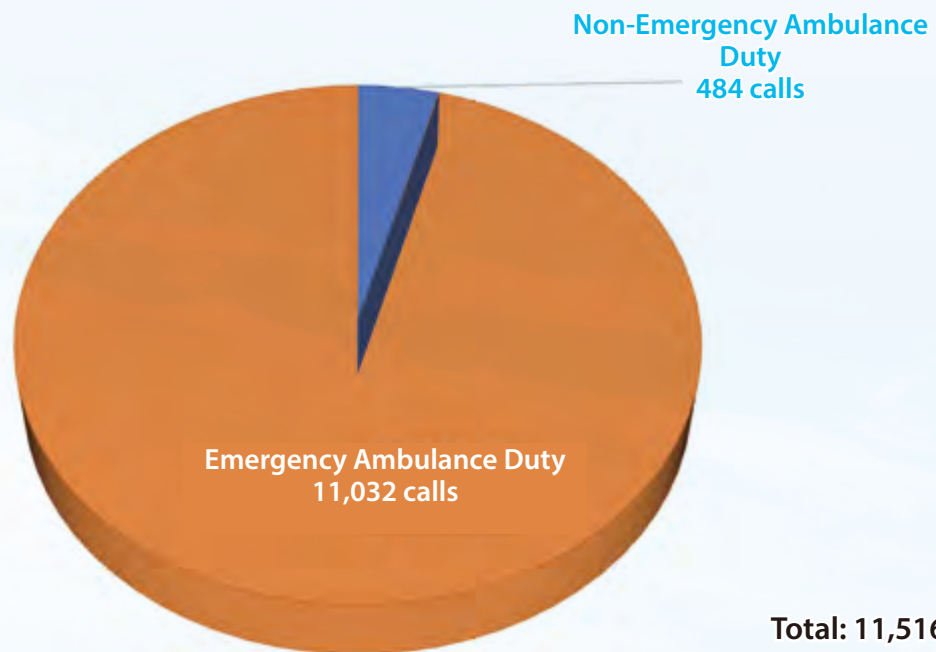
