- 1980年經當局正式批准，成立為非牟利的社團，名為「大坑東及南山邨居民委員會」
- 1997年本會正式成為慈善團體，並由「大坑東及南山邨居民委員會」改名「深水埗社區協會」，進一步將服務範圍擴大。

服務宗旨

- 本會深水埗社區協會為地區居民組織，至今服務社區40年
- 提供非牟利慈善服務，使老弱、貧困或有特殊需要的人仕得到關懷和照顧。服務對象為老人、婦女和青少年人
- 服務地域為深水埗區
- 組織基層長者，改善長者生活；舉辦健康檢查、協助申請社會福利等 組織青年及婦女探訪老人，訪貧問苦 個案轉介服務；節慶送暖等探訪活動 在社區內培訓資深義工，並有豐富籌辦大型長者活動經驗。

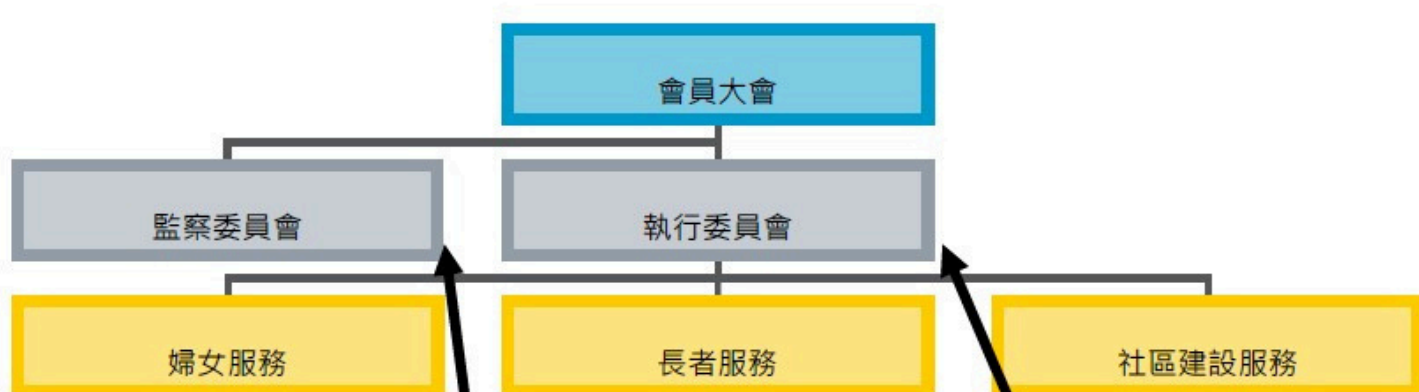

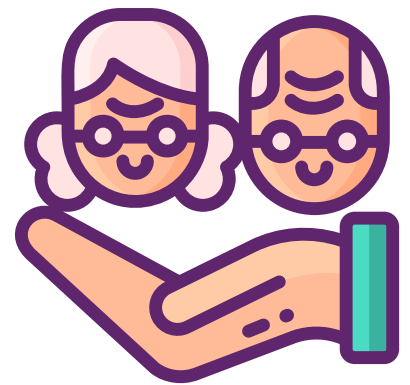

2022-23年度 工作報告概要

過往一年本會在社區義工及組織者的協助下，開展各項不同類型社區服務。

1. 長者小組服務

透過定期小組活動、定時電話聯繫以及社區聚會，維繫約180多名核心成員，向長者提供各類社區及長者資訊，增強長者間的互助團結，並討長者關心的議題，鼓勵長者發表社區政策建議，接觸社區內外最新資訊。我們同時亦耆康互助行動：組織社區資深義工、青年、婦女以及其他服務團體，定期探訪區內低收入、獨居、兩老同住及其他有需要的長者，以提供即時的生活支援。籌劃各類大型社區活動，協助長者組織互助網絡，按服務使用者需要提供專題社區教育及義工服務。



2. 婦女小組服務

定期為區內婦女提供各項生活 / 政策資訊、社區關愛及義工活動，加強社區團結，預防各種家庭問題發生。同時亦組織區內婦女義工，協助籌辦大型活動及參與社區探訪。

3. 社區建設服務

我們就特定議題，在區內舉辦不同類型的聚會、走訪及小組活動。透過組織社區及政策關注小組，鼓勵居民及義工關注基層社區議題，並進行社區調查，了解社區需要。此外，我們鼓勵居民參與、結連及外訪其他社區組織，學習不同的社區工作經驗，提升他們的社區的參與度，使各項社區服務得以持續發展。

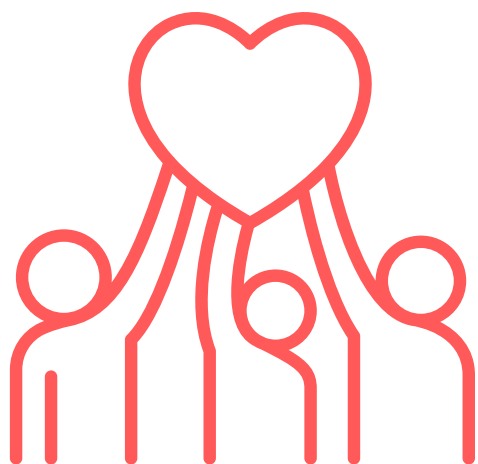


4. 在疫情後恢復服務

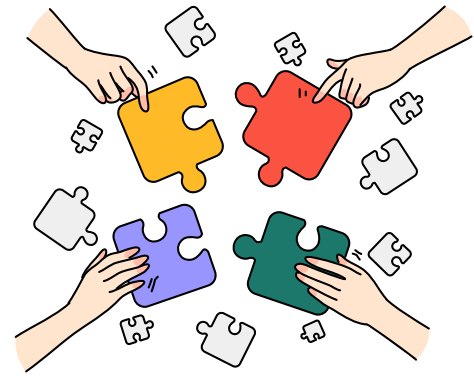

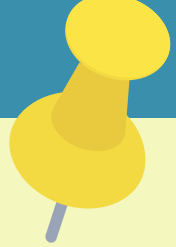

REPORT ON THE AUDIT OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

Opinion

We have audited the financial statements of Sham Shui Po Community Association Limited (the "Association") set out on pages 5 to 11, which comprise the statement of financial position as at 31 March 2023, and the income statement for the year then ended, and notes to the financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies.

In our opinion, the financial statements of the Association are prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the Hong Kong Small and Medium-sized Entity Financial Reporting Standard ("SME-FRS") issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants ("HKICPA") and have been properly prepared in compliance with the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with Hong Kong Standards on Auditing ("HKSAs") and with reference to Practice Note 900 (Revised) "Audit of Financial Statements Prepared in Accordance with the SME-FRS issued by the HKICPA. In connection with our audit of the financial statements, our responsibility is to read the other information and, in doing so, consider whether the other information is materially inconsistent with the financial statements or our knowledge obtained in the audit or otherwise appears to be materially misstated. If, based on the work we have performed, we conclude that there is a material misstatement of this other information, we are required to report that fact. We have nothing to report in this regard.

REPORTING ENTITY

Sham Shui Po Community Association Limited ("the Association") was a company incorporated in Hong Kong and limited by guarantee and not having share capital. The Association's registered office is located at Room 10-11, G/F., Tung Shing House, Tai Hang Tung Estate, Kowloon. The principal activities of the Association are providing non-profitable charity and social welfare services to the residents in Sham Shui Po District, Hong Kong.

Under the provision of the Association's Memorandum And Articles of Association, every member shall in the event of the Association being wound up, contribute such amount as may be required to meet the liabilities of the Association, but not exceeding the sum of HK\$10.

1. BASIS OF PREPARATION AND ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The Association qualifies for the reporting exemption as a small guarantee company under section 359(1)(a) and 363 of the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance (Cap. 622) and is therefore entitled to prepare and present its financial statements in accordance with the Small and Medium-sized Entity Financial Reporting Standard ("SME-FRS") issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants.

These financial statements comply with the SME-FRS and have been prepared under the accrual basis of accounting and on the basis that the Association is a going concern.

The measurement base used in the preparation of the financial statements is historical cost.

The following are the specific accounting policies that are necessary for a proper understanding of the financial statements:-

(a) Revenue

Revenue is recognized when it is probable that the economic benefits will flow to the Association and when the revenue can be measured reliably, on the following bases:

- (i) Revenue from funding received from the Community Chest, donation received, subscription and fees received and social welfare subvention received are recognized when the right to receive payment is established
- (ii) Member's subscription income is recognized when the subscription is due;
- (iii) Donation income is recognized when the donation is received; and
- (iv) Interest income is recognized on a time proportion basis taking into account the principal outstanding and the interest rate applicable

1. BASIS OF PREPARATION AND ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONT'D)

(b) Property, plant and equipment

Property, plant and equipment are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation and accumulated impairment losses.

The depreciable amount of an item of property, plant and equipment is allocated on a systematic basis over its estimated useful life using the straight-line method. The principal annual rate used for depreciation is as follows:

Furniture and fixtures	20%
Equipment	20%
Leasehold improvement	20%

(c) Impairment of assets

An assessment is made at each statement of financial position date to determine whether there is any indication of impairment or reversal of previous impairment, including items of property, plant and equipment. In the event that the asset's carrying amount exceeds its recoverable amount, the carrying amount is reduced to recoverable amount and an impairment loss is recognized in the income statement. A previously recognized impairment loss is reversed only if there has been a change in estimates used to determine the recoverable amount, however not to an amount higher than the carrying amount that would have been determined (net of amortization or depreciation), had no impairment losses been recognized for the asset in prior years.

(d) Leases

Lease payments under an operating lease are recognised as expenses on a straight-line basis over the lease term. All incentives for agreement of a new or renewed operating lease are recognised as an integral part of the net consideration agreed for the use of the leased assets. The aggregate benefit of incentives is recognised as a reduction of rental expenses over the lease term.
