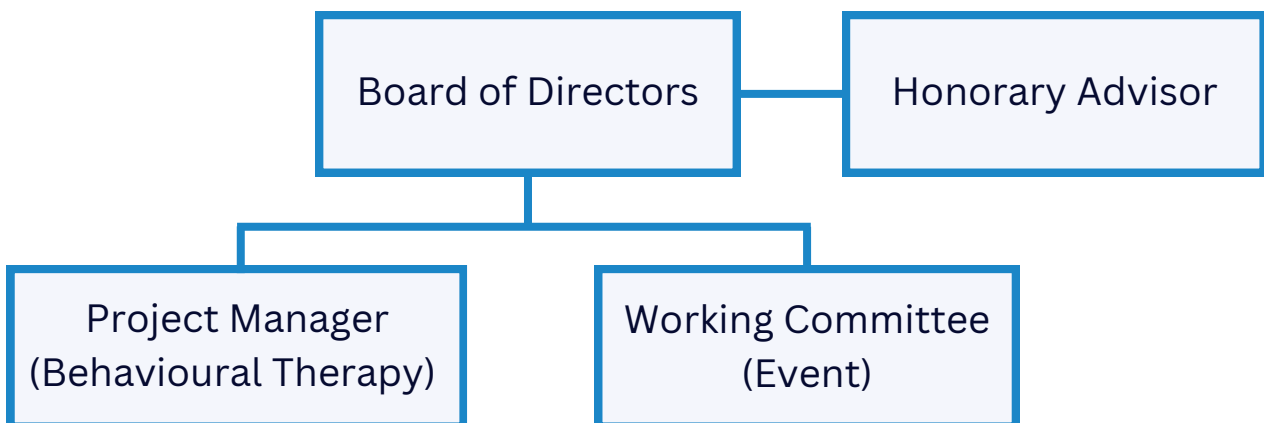

1 to 1 Session

One of the main objectives of Bridge Foundation is to provide quality behavioural therapy to underprivileged SEN students.



Over the past year, we have sponsored over 5 students and they have received 1-to-1 behavioural therapy for over 1500 hours, helping them with their needs in various areas such as school readiness, social and communication, and self-help skills.

Social Group

Besides observation and 1-to-1 sessions, we also sponsor SEN students in need to join our weekly social group. This is to help them learn skills to survive and thrive in various social scenarios and learn how to communicate and interact with other children.



Seminar and Talk - February 2023

To promote awareness and understanding of students with SEN in school settings, we hosted an online seminar in collaboration with primary school teachers. Designed for parents, the seminar highlighted the importance of teamwork among teachers, supervisors, and parents in fostering children's progress. With over 20 parents participating, the event provided valuable insights to help them better support their children's development.

Free Tickets for Hong Kong Ballet Performance - April 2023

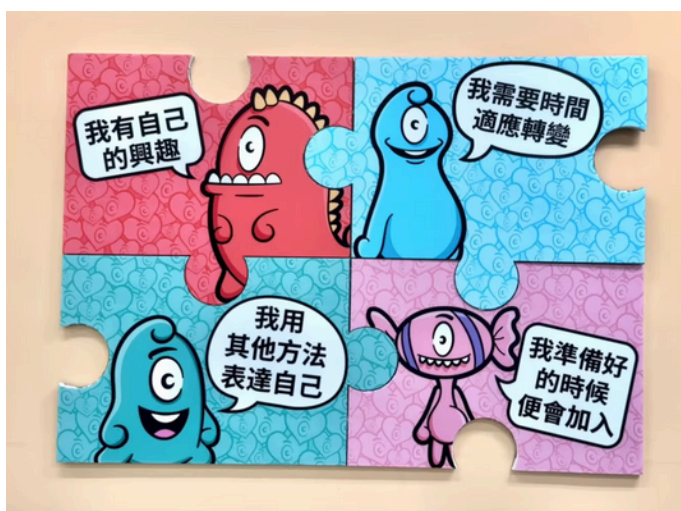
